Accomplishments for 2008-2009

- The Senior Community Center implemented the Stanford University Chronic Disease Self Management Program providing a six week workshop series to more than 80 older adults.
- The Senior Community Center received training and licensure to start the Stanford University Diabetes Self Management Program.
- The Adult Day Service Program implemented an array of support services targeted toward clinically nursing home eligible older adults. From this group, 90% were able to avoid nursing home placement.
- The Vintage Board of Directors completed a strategic planning framework for the period 2009 - 2012 with four overarching strategies:
 - Lead the region in developing a high-quality model of comprehensive resources for the wellness of seniors
 - Seek and engage in partnerships that promote wellness, support quality and strengthen the organization's capacity
 - Substantially increase the base of individual givers, members and corporate sponsors with new strategies and enhanced communications
 - Implement sustainability conditions that preserve quality, maintain a core level of public support, stabilize the endowment, and create operational efficiencies.

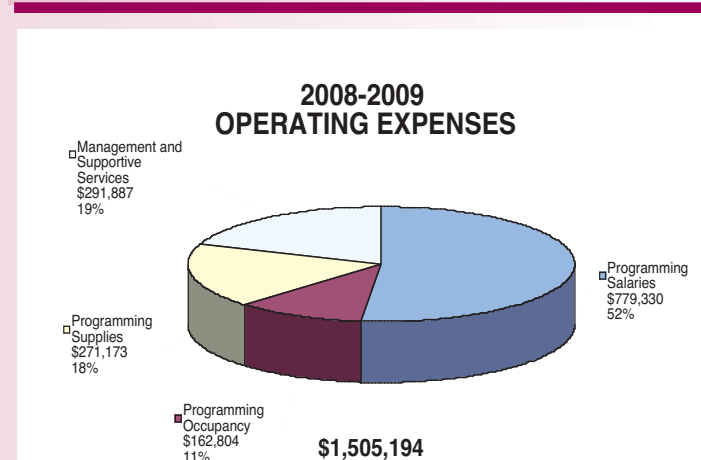
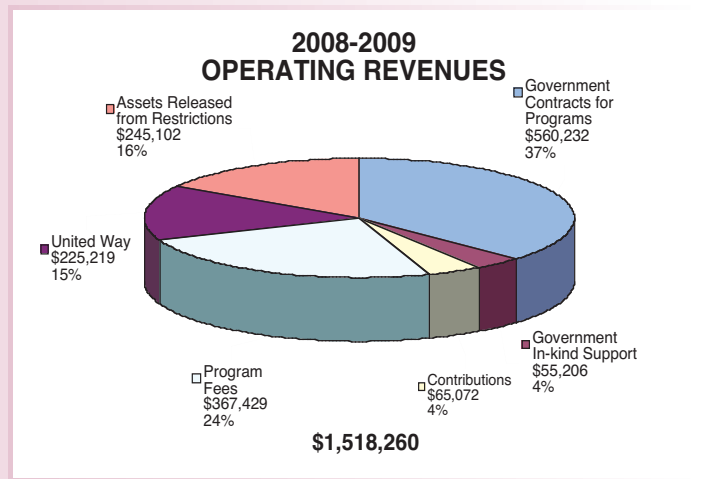
